



It is possible to book only the massage or acupuncture portions of the workshop for those who have completed one portion previously; however it is highly recommended that both portions are taken together. The massage/acupressure taught the first day provides ample time for learning the techniques used throughout the weekend, and greatly enhance the treatment.

Early booking is recommended as workshops sell out well in advance and attendance is limited to 28 participants maximum. Virginia Doran will be accompanied by two experienced assistants to ensure adequate individual attention and clinical supervision.

About the instructor:

Virginia Doran M.Ac, L.Ac, LMT (USA)



Virginia Doran has been a teacher and lecturer in the field of holistic health since 1980 on the subjects of massage therapy, acupuncture, aromatherapy, flower essences, Chinese and Western herbs, nutrition and supplements.

Ms Doran is a graduate of the Tri-State College for Traditional Chinese Acupuncture as well as their postgraduate course in Chinese Herbology, and she is nationally certified (NCCAOM) in acupuncture and Chinese Herbology.

She graduated from the Swedish Institute of Massage and Allied Health Sciences in 1978, where she has since taught postgraduate courses and has been a licensed massage therapist practicing since 1979.

Ms Doran has recently had the great honour of being the first Westerner to teach an acupuncture workshop in Japan.

Ms Doran has been sought out by major television networks to demonstrate acupuncture facial Rejuvenation and has been featured in, and been a consultant to many magazines on acupuncture for facial rejuvenation and dermatological conditions.

To share with others the benefits of her publicity, Virginia created a referral service on her website for her students. She is currently writing two books on facial rejuvenation, one for practitioners and one for the public.

Virginia produced and released her instructional DVD on Facial Rejevenation Acupuncture in 2012.

Workshop Programme

Friday 11 October 2013, 11.00-18.30 (6.5 hours)

Day 1 - Massage

Open to acupuncturists, TCM practitioners, final year acupuncture students and massage practitioners. Massage is an integral part of rejuvenating the face, and this hands-on training compliments the results of the acupuncture treatment.

Day 1

- Facial massage and acupressure techniques for the face
- Point location and techniques practice
- Benefits and contraindications for facial massage
- Specific techniques for signs of aging and imbalance such as double chins, puffiness, and furrows

Saturday 12 October & Sunday 13 October 2013, 10.00-18.30 both days (15 hours) Days 2 & 3 - Acupuncture certification

(Please note certification is not quaranteed-you must pass both written and practical exams)

The acupuncture portion is open only to acupuncturists and TCM practitioners. Students nearing the end of their final clinical year with insurance will be considered. This part of the course includes a practical examination and short written test that must be passed in order to receive Virginia Doran's certification.

Day 2

- History and philosophy of facial acupuncture
- Treatments, benefits, guidelines & contraindications
- Supplies & sources for equipment
- Point selection, protocols and needle techniques for specific conditions such as eye bags, sagging and jowls, drooping eyelids, lip area wrinkles, double chin, redness, dry skin, pallor, facial puffiness including eyelids, facial redness, dry skin, enlarged pores, acne, eyebrow sparseness, age spots, broken capillaries, scars, protruding temporal veins, cheekbone sculpting
- Other important points for the face including distal and auricular points
- Practical demonstration

Day 3

- Written exam 25 multiple choice questions
- Practical clinical experience participants pair up and administer treatment on each other
- Practical exam participants administer treatment to volunteers (do you have a friend who would like a free treatment? Bring them along to be your patient!)
- Q&A and certification

General Information

Confirmation of booking

Bookings are confirmed in writing and full details will be provided along with a receipt for payment. If you have not received email or letter confirmation within 3 weeks, please contact us to check we have received it. Information about the venue location and local accommodation will be sent with confirmation

Fees

The fee includes essential supplies, handouts and certificate. Tea and snacks will be supplied and lunch can be purchased from a range of nearby eateries. Payment must be received before confirmation can be made.

Cancellations

Fees are non-refundable within 28 days prior to the commencement of the course. All refunds are subject to a 10% cancellation fee. In the event the course is cancelled by Tian Garden Workshops or Ms Doran, as much notice as possible will be given and a full refund awarded. However we are unable to reimburse travel or any other costs.

Treatment

Participants are required to give and receive treatment and sign a consent form. Please dress for a full body treatment. For certification participants are required to undertake a practical examination on Sunday 13 Oct 2013. You are invited to bring a friend / colleague to give your treatment to in pairs with another participant. Please indicate below if you are able to bring a patient. They will need to be at the venue between 3.30pm and 6.30pm and will be required to sign a consent form.

Contraindications

Facial Acupuncture is contraindicated for some pituitary disorders, heart disorders, diabetes mellitus, high blood pressure, individuals who have a pacemaker or who have a problem with bleeding or bruising, or who currently suffer from migraine headaches. Facial Acupuncture should not be done during pregnancy, during a bout of cold or flu, during an allergic attack or during an acute herpes outbreak.
